**International Conference on  
Transitional Perspective on Global Financial Crises**

Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan - November 5, 2009

The international conference is hosted by International Ataturk Alatau University in cooperation with The Ministry of Finance of Kyrgyz Republic, Academy of Management under the President of the Kyrgyz Republic, American University in Central Asia, Kyrgyz - Russian Slavic University, East University named after Mahmud Kashgari Barskani, and Eurasian Journal of Business and Economics.

Much of the discussion on the global financial and mortgage crisis has focused on the causes and governance issues related to international lending, monetary policy and weak regulation. It has largely focused on the advanced capitalist economies, although there is now increasing recognition that developing countries are severely affected by the crisis. The economic aspect of the crisis itself in developing transitional economies has received little attention.

Today, many reputable national and international banks, financial institution and prominent companies have lived bankruptcy. What do such closures in the advanced capitalist countries mean for developing transitional economies? How do such actions effect the developing world's banking and financial systems? What types of spaces do they create for alternative ways of thinking about transitional economy's role in the global market system?

Priority will be given to proposals, which take an original, creative approach to a specific question related to the conference theme, and considers this question in terms of more than one country or culture. Interdisciplinary proposals are especially encouraged. The conference welcomes submissions from academic scholars, government experts, and all contributors from international organizations, private institutions and companies. The themes of the conference are listed below:

- Financial systems of transition economies
- Financial system integration
- Financial system security
- International Financial Institutions
- Risk management
- Monetary policies
- Exchange rate
- Banking system and reforms
- Capital markets
- Shadow economy

Proposals are accepted in English, Turkish, Russian and/or Kyrgyz.

Complete applications must include the following:

- 1 page proposal submitted in MS Word (including title, abstract (350 words) and keys words;
- Full names and affiliation of all authors, corresponding author's name, full postal address, telephone number, fax number, and e-mail address
- Author's CV
- Panel and roundtable discussion papers will be accepted

- Accepted papers will be announced at October 10, 2009
- Deadline for full-text paper submission (in word format) is November 1, 2009
